ERASMUS+**PROGRAMME FOR C5/TN5 - FIGUERES - NOVEMBER 2018**

The current context is marked by the doubts expressed by a segment of the public opinion on the building of Europe. Values such as compromise and citizenship are necessary in our society. The project "Young Europeans who make history", whose topic is the commitment of the youth in European contemporary history, is framed in this context. A commitment which has allowed democracy, despite adversity, to prevail in Europe, a democracy of which we are heirs today.

One of the goals of the Project is to raise awareness among young and elder people about European citizenship. Other goals are also to motivate students with innovative project pedagogy, while promoting the acquisition of key competences defined by the EU in 2006. It is also about raising awareness to the performers related to the educational community (teachers and non-teachers, students, parents, institutions) and opening the school to its local, regional and European environment.

There are approximately 400 15 to 18 year-old students actively taking part in this project in five schools: Berthelot Secondary School in Toulouse (France, coordinating institution), Olivar Gran High School in Figueres (Spain), Liceo Marco Belli in Portogruaro (Italy), Schloss-Gymnasium in Düsseldorf (Germany), Pilates Gimnazija in Vilnius (Lithuania).
